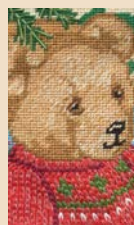

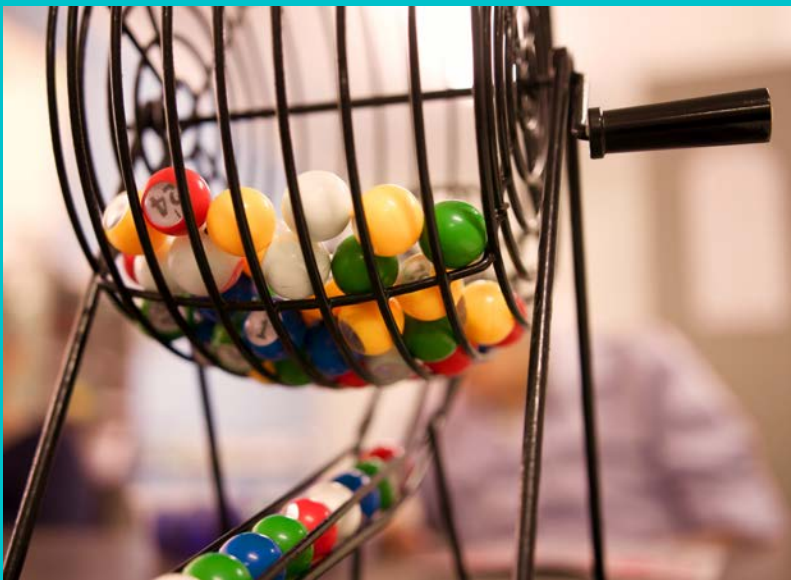

## **Grand Marshall 2022**

### **Kenny Kennedy**

It is an honor to have Kenny Kennedy as this year's Grand Marshall for the Piute County Fair. Kenny has lived in Piute County (Marysvale) his entire life. Kenny married Rhonda Ackerman on September 1, 1970. Kenny lost Rhonda in 2016 but before her passing, they raised Penny, Travis, and Jenna on the family ranch in Marysvale where they both taught them the value of hard work and helping others. Their family continued to grow and now Kenny can, and frequently does brag, about his 14 grandchildren and 4 great-grandchildren.

Kenny has worked hard his entire life. After graduating from high school, he attended Southern Utah State College (now SUU) for one year but knew that he belonged back in Marysvale. Upon returning home, Kenny worked at the uranium mines for one year, then at the Deer Trail Mine. In 1972 Kenny went into the dairy business with his brother for nearly 10 years. He sold his part of the dairy to his brother and began ranching and raising beef cattle till he "retired".

Kenny has always been active in community events. He was the Fireman's Club president for 3 years and a part of the organization for many more. During his time with the club, he helped put on horse races, rodeos, parades, and other events. Time has not changed much for Kenny.
